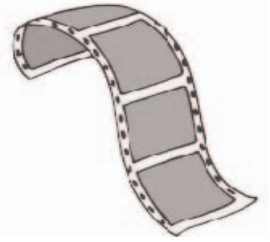

Receiving

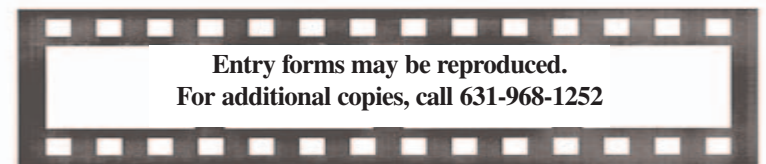
